Project 1: Green Team - TPM Kaizen

TPM kaizen – apply the concepts of TPM with a strong focus on instilling a culture of autonomous maintenance on equipment located in a sterile manufacturing facility. During the week, the downtime history will be interrogated, the PM content will be reviewed and daily checks linked to the introduction of a TPM board for the area to drive sustainability into the future.

Project 2: Blue Team - Pack Line Change Over Kaizen

Pack Line Changeover kaizen – as the business becomes more complex with a dramatic increase in the number of SKUs within packaging, the need for efficient and rapid changeover becomes essential. By applying the lean tools of SMED to the changeover of a packaging line, a step change in changeover time is sought, hence unleashing the potential for increased throughput in the midst of increasing complexity.

Project 3: Red Team - Technical Transfer Kaizen

Technical Transfer Kaizen - a business process kaizen to map current state activity in product transfers to and from the manufacturing facility in Waterford and to design a future state process that delivers both right first time and reduced lead-times for product transfers though eliminating non value adding activities in the current process and embedding clarity of ownership.
